The many aspects of a market

- Offering of a wide variety of products (public-collected, private-grown)
- Attracting critical mass to sustain the market infrastructure
- Logistics, transport (hand carried, horse carriage, truck, transport services)
- Food, fabrics processing (preparation, colouring, cutting, sewing)
- Transaction platforms (barter, currency)
- Business models, valuation (offering vs. demand, uniqueness)
- Warranty (tracing back to the original manufacturer)
- Supervision

The many aspects of a market

...transposed to the data domain

- Offering of a wide variety of domain data (public, private)
- Attracting critical mass to be able to sustain the transaction platform
- Transported, real time or aggregated, networks (P2P, fog, cloud, services)
- Data cleaning, anonymisation, pseudonymisation, selection
- Secure transaction platforms, micropayment, DLT
- Business models, valuation
- Warranty (original ownership, liability, authentication)
- Supervision (ethical and legal frameworks)
