## Collaborating towards a sustainable market

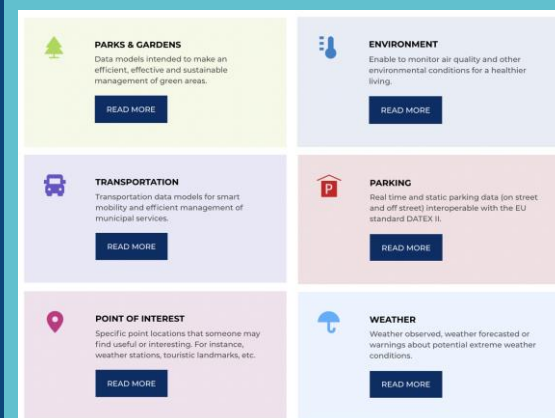
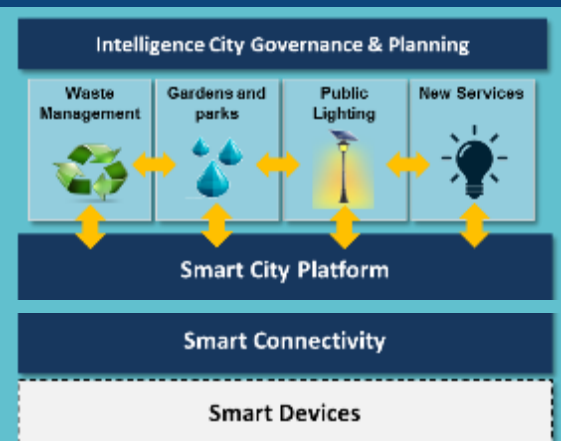
- Common Info Models

## Enabling the Data Economy

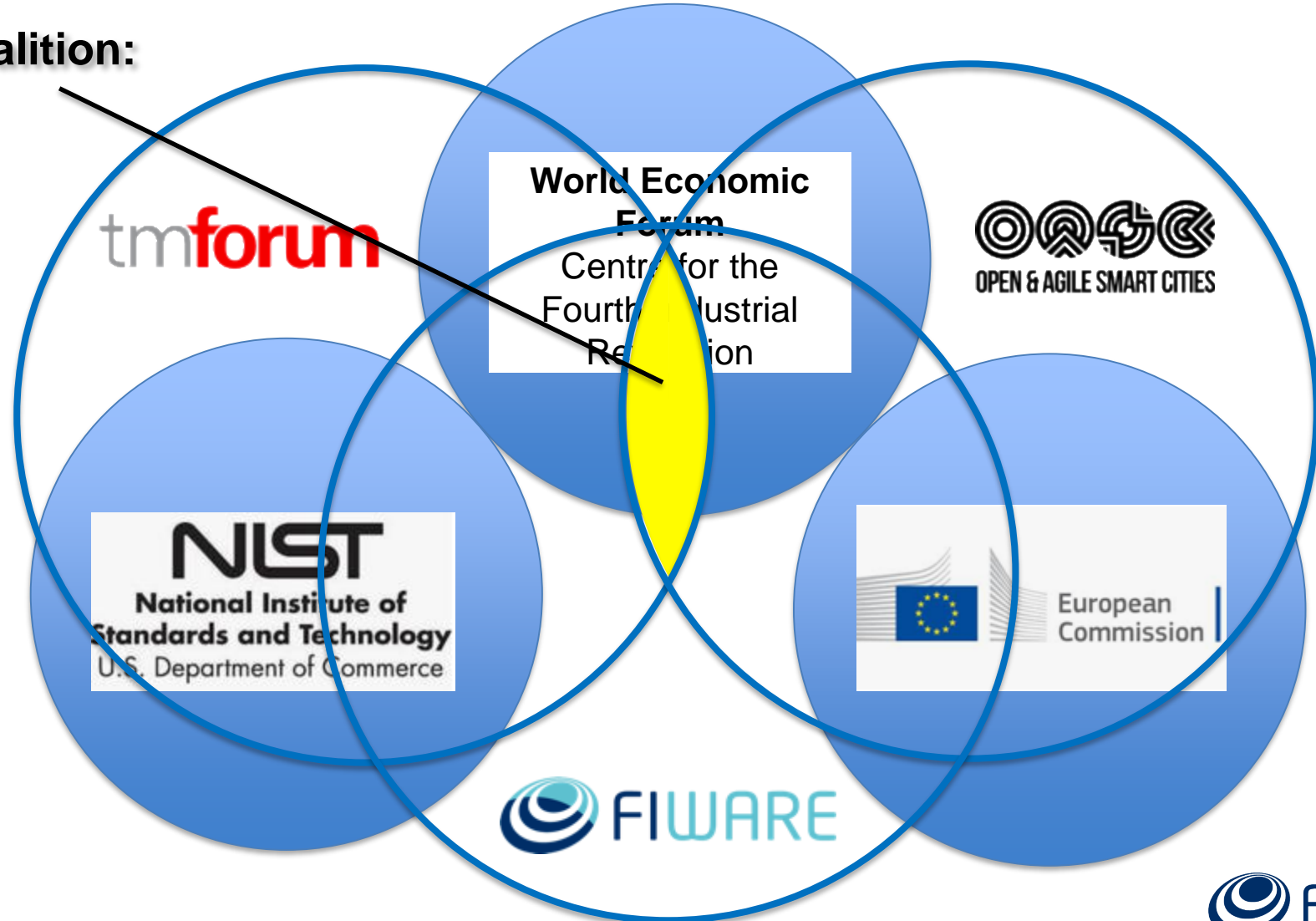
- City as a platform including also 3<sup>rd</sup> party data enabling innovative business models

# Major milestone on this journey have been achieved

- **Communiqués of the B20 meeting, March 14<sup>th</sup>/15:**

*As the world continues to urbanise, in order to tackle global issues and realise sustainable development, it is required to successfully manage urban growth. To this end, **we, the B20, propose that smart cities be a focus of the G20's ...***

**(5) Launch real world projects**

*... a **global smart city coalition** could promote transparency, openness and interoperability, develop appropriate regulatory frameworks and help cities to become platforms for the data economy. As part of exploratory approaches, **each G20 country is expected to nominate prospective cities.***

- **G20 Ministerial Statement on Trade and Digital Economy. June 8th and 9th**

**Smart Cities:** ... the G20 encourages networking and experience-sharing among cities for the development of smart cities, recommended by the Business 20 and the Urban 20. ... Cities and networks of cities that express an interest may join a **Global Smart City Coalition**, which has been proposed to be established in October.
