- Focused on
 - building the strategic digital capacities of the EU
 - facilitating the wide deployment of digital technologies
- Clean, sustainable and smart Communities and Mobility
 - Priority actions for the first two years
 - Deployment of Open Cross-sectorial Urban Platforms and Cross-border Mobility as a Service (MaaS) solutions
 - Deployment of innovative smart city and smart mobility applications by SMEs and start-ups
 - Testing and experimentation facilities (TEF)

Digital Europe Communities



Programme – MaaS

- Open, Interoperable, Trustworthy
- Combined with Regional Funds
- AI-driven services
- Application area for AI, HPC and cybersecurity
- Digital Innovation Hubs instrument for implementation
- Complemented by CEF Digital (digital operational platforms)
- Mission area on Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities in Horizon Europe
- Proposed partnership on Connected Automated Mobility
- Urban Agenda for EU Digital Transition Partnership

Horizon Europe



- Intervention area on Smart Cities (but also Smart buildings, mobility, etc.)
- Mission on Climate Neutral and Smart Cities
 - One of 5 in Horizon Europe
 - Cross-cutting
 - "Managing" 10% of budget
 - 15 Board members
 - 30 assembly members
 - Deliver missions descriptions and output document by year end

- 5G smart communities Fibre backhaul & Gigabit connectivity for socio-economic drivers and citizens
- 5G4EU Equipment for smart communities
- Digital Operational Platforms and Synergies between Energy/Transport and Digital
