# AI for Public Services: Challenges

- Governments are increasingly seeking to capture the opportunities offered by automated decision-making algorithmic systems (i.e. AI) to improve their services.
- However, government agencies and the general public have justified concerns over bias, privacy, accountability, and transparency of such automated decision-making processes.

# MIM5: Core Objective

“Cities and communities will have the technical capabilities required to verify that the algorithmic systems offered by suppliers to make decisions about the services offered to citizens are fair, trustworthy and transparent.”

*(This includes the models used, the datasets on which the algorithms are trained, and the data that the models use to make decisions.)*

# MIM5: Benefits

- MIM5 will provide a technical foundation to help cities and communities validate algorithmic systems.
- MIM5 specifications and approach will support to safeguard a transparent and fair procurement process for AI-based public services
- MIM5 will provide a framework to contribute to the interoperability and reusability of AI solutions across cities and domains.
